1. Rationale

This document is a brief introduction for ERUA researchers seeking guidance on how to connect to research infrastructure and resources available within the Alliance.

A second version of Guidelines on Infrastructure Sharing Procedures for researcher will be provided on the Research Portal that will be assessible on the ERUA Research Portal on September 2023

It builds on previous documents produced within this work package, specifically: the Mapping of R&I internal and external (infra)structures, resources and networks (Deliverable 6.1; updated version attached here as Appendix 1) and the Existing infrastructures and resources sharing assessment and action plan (Deliverable 6.2).

It presents the most up-to-date information related to:

- research infrastructure availability
- rules governing its use
- research support resources.

(R&I infrastructure 2. Research infrastructure and resources)

The subject-matter of this document, Research infrastructure, or research and innovation (R&I) infrastructure and resources, is understood here following the definition provided by the EU Commission (https://ec.europa.eu/info/research-andinnovation/strategy/strategy-2020-2024/our-digital-future/european-research-infrastructures_en):

"Research Infrastructures are facilities that provide resources and services for research communities to conduct research and foster innovation. They can be used beyond research e.g. for education or public services and they may be single-sited, distributed, or virtual. They include:

- major scientific equipment or sets of instruments
- collections, archives or scientific data
- computing systems and communication networks
- any other research and innovation infrastructure of a unique nature which is open to external users."

As of the date of writing this report, the most up-to-date available listing of research infrastructure with the Alliance is the updated *Map* referred to earlier (see Appendix 1).













3. Rules of Use

As indicated by our survey of research unit leaders (conducted in the summer of 2022, described in Deliverable 6.2, referred to above) access to research infrastructure within the Alliance is open in principle.

However, there are rules and requirements specific to research units, the type of infrastructure concerned as well as to ERUA members that govern the use of infrastructure. Access conditions are based on the internal policies of the research units housing research infrastructures. Typically, and internal managing committee within each research unit evaluates all requests for use based on the virtues of the research agenda presented by the requesting party.

Similarly, detailed requirements related to intellectual property rights and research ethics standards are not centrally mandated but subject to internal policy within research units.

ERUA researchers who are interested in requesting use of research infrastructure available within the Alliance are advised to get in touch with the research unit housing the infrastructure in question. (A website or contact for each research unit can be found in the *Map* in Appendix 1.) In contacting the respective research units, researchers should provide the following information about their request:

- their name, position and institutional affiliation
- title, timeframe and brief description of research project
- explanation of need for use of specific infrastructure
- Period for use of specific infrastructure

ERUA researchers who are interested in requesting use of research infrastructure available within the Alliance can also look forward to help from the Network of Research Support Offices within ERUA.















By September 2023 ERUA researchers will have available the Research Portal, (to be developed by Re:ERUA WP2, WP6 an IT staff in link with the ERUA WP5) for sharing all relevant information related to research, including research infrastructure, within the Alliance. Besides all information currently included in the Map this Research Portal will incorporate data on individual researchers and will link to information about research infrastructure such as:

- Services available
- Access requirements, criteria and regulations
- Access fee (if any)
- Shared calendar of use and availability
- Technical staff and contacts.

Already now a **Network of Research Support Offices** within the Alliance is available to advise and help connect researchers to other researchers and/or research infrastructure within ERUA. All researchers seeking partnership and collaboration with other researchers within the Alliance are encouraged - though not required - to use the services of their local research support office.






